Dear Parents and Carers,

This half term in Year 3, our topic will focus on biomes around the world. To support our new topic, we have organised a trip to RHS Wisley Gardens. During this trip the children will have the opportunity to explore the gardens and the glass house which will allow them to compare canopies from a deciduous forest and rainforest biome.

The trip will take place on **Wednesday 22nd May 2024**, leaving Mayhill at 9am and returning by 3.20pm. Should we experience any delay due to traffic you will be informed by email. We are asking for a contribution of £15.00 per child to cover the cost of entry and transport. This trip is part of the curriculum and as such, it is important that all children attend.

We will require some parent helpers for this trip, if you are able to help please email the admin office as soon as possible.

The children are to wear school uniform and sensible shoes or trainers. Please ensure they have a waterproof coat with them, a sun hat and sun cream already applied if necessary. They will need a morning snack, packed lunch and a water bottle (no glass, fizzy drink, nuts or chocolate please).

If your child is entitled to free school meals, you will not be expected to pay for this trip. However, we do require you provide consent online via SCOPAY. If your child is entitled to free school meals and you would like your child to have a school packed lunch, please indicate on the online form.

Any medicines, including travel sickness tablets, must be labelled and given to your child's teacher; along with a medicines permission form which can be obtained from the school office. The children will not need any additional money as we will not be visiting a shop.
